Please read before entering Sayuri World

- Our park focuses on the theme of 'coexistence among animals' and 'coexistence between humans and animals.' Therefore, various animals such as llamas, kangaroos, capybaras, and rabbits live freely in the central square. To interact with the animals in a friendly manner, please cooperate with the following guidelines:
1. Please do not shout loudly, run, or chase after the animals.
 2. Do not touch or pick up animals, or put your hands near their heads or mouths.
 3. When offering food, make sure to give it to the animals without retracting your hand.
 4. Young children must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
 5. When petting animals, gently stroke them from their neck.
 6. Please do not touch the giraffes.
 7. Engaging in dangerous activities or harassing animals may result in expulsion from the park at the discretion of the staff.
 8. Do not feed the animals anything other than the food sold at the park.
 9. Baby strollers are not allowed. Please store them in the designated area.
 10. Please be mindful not to litter or drop garbage in the park.

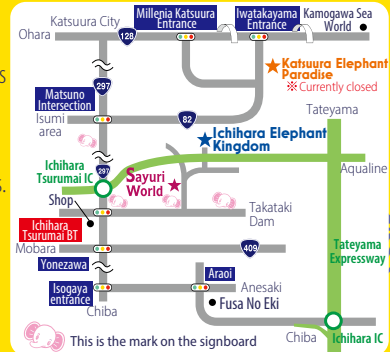

1 What's the difference between African and Asian elephants?

	African Elephant	Asian Elephant

2 How much do elephants eat?

Elephants eat about 80 to 100 kg a day. Their diet includes grass, bamboo, fruits, vegetables, rice and etc. Also, they drink about 100 liters of water a day.

3 How do elephants communicate with each other?

They communicate using sounds that can be heard by humans, and also with low-frequency sounds (below 20 hertz) that are inaudible to the human ear. Adult elephants are said to be able to communicate using low-frequency sounds from a distance of 30 km, and children are said to be able to communicate using low-frequency sounds at close range. When elephants touch their noses or baby elephants press their heads together, they may be having a secret conversation.

4 Why is it difficult to breed in zoos?

Elephant are very intelligent and emotional animals. In order for breeding to be successful, it is important not only to have compability between male and female, but also to make the elephant feel that it is safe to leave offspring here. Thanks to elephant handlers from Thailand, our zoo has successfully bred four Asian elephants, the most in Japan, and give birth to six.

5 How do elephants get pregnant and raise their children?

The gestation period is 20 to 22 months. The weight at birth is approximately 100 to 150 kg. Children stay with their mother until they are around 2 or 3 years old. Her fellow elephants also raise their children together. Our zoo is the only zoo in Japan where you can meet the four elephant sisters.
